## The SPPS Style

**Jewelry:** Boys and girls may wear a watch, one bracelet and one small simple silver or gold chain necklace with a Catholic religious medal or cross. Girls may wear one or two pairs of simple post earrings only (Cartilage piercings are not allowed.) No other jewelry is permitted.

**Nail polish:** Not allowed except clear or French white tip.
