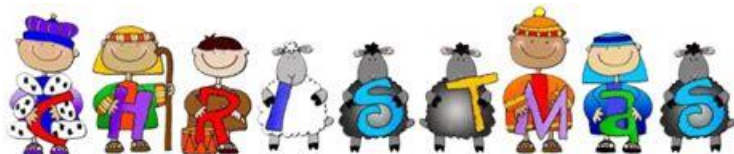

The First Week of Advent at SPSS

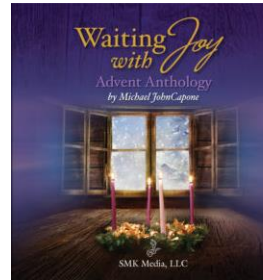

Entering into Advent

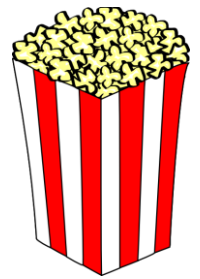
